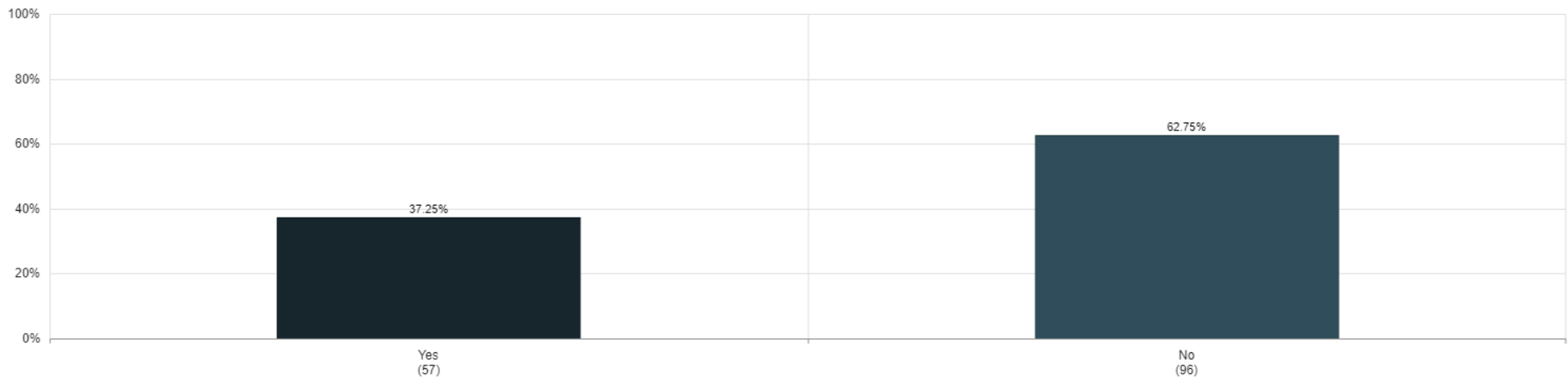
9. If you could bring any Arts & Culture event, activity or facility to Carson City what would it be?
